Mr. SMITH of Virginia, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon the adoption of this
2 resolution it shall be in order to move that the House resolve
3 itself into the Committee of the Whole House on the State
4 of the Union for the consideration of the joint resolution
5 (H. J. Res. 430) approving the constitution of the Com-
6 monwealth of Puerto Rico on March 3, 1952. That after
7 general debate which shall be confined to the joint reso-
8 lution and continue not to exceed two hours, to be equally
9 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority
10 member of the Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs,
11 the joint resolution shall be read for amendment under the
12 five-minute rule. At the conclusion of the consideration of

1 the joint resolution for amendment, the Committee shall rise
2 and report the joint resolution to the House with such
3 amendments as may have been adopted and the previous
4 question shall be considered as ordered on the joint reso-
5 tion and amendments thereto to final passage without inter-
6 vening motion except one motion to recommit.
