Mr. Dole (for himself, Mr. D'Amato, Mr. Simon, and Mr. Matsunaga) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To provide for a referendum in Puerto Rico on the admission of Puerto Rico into the Union as a State.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. FINDINGS.
- 4 The Congress finds that—
- 5 (1) States have been admitted to the Union only
- 6 after residents of the proposed States have requested
- 7 statehood;
- 8 (2) residents of Puerto Rico have been given only
- 9 one opportunity, in 1967, to determine for themselves

- 1 whether they wish Puerto Rico to be admitted to the
- 2 Union as a State; and
- 3 (3) as citizens of the United States, residents of
- 4 Puerto Rico should be allowed to express themselves
- 5 once again on being admitted to the Union.

6 SEC. 2. REFERENDUM

- 7 (a) Upon the call of the Governor of Puerto Rico, an
- 8 islandwide referendum shall be held in Puerto Rico in order
- 9 to enable the qualified voters of the Commonwealth of Puerto
- 10 Rico to vote for admission of Puerto Rico into the Union.
- 11 The referendum shall occur no earlier than January 1, 1989,
- 12 and not later than December 31, 1994. In the referendum
- 13 the qualified electors of the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico
- 14 shall vote for the adoption or rejection of the following propo-
- 15 sition: "Shall Puerto Rico be admitted into the Union as a
- 16 State?".
- 17 (b) The returns of the referendum held under this Act
- 18 shall be made to the Governor of Puerto Rico, who shall
- 19 cause them to be canvassed in the manner provided by law
- 20 for the canvass of votes cas in general elections in the Com-
- 21 monwealth of Puerto Rico. If a majority of the qualified
- 22 voters voting in a referendum under this Act vote in favor of
- 23 admission into the Union, the Governor shall certify to the
- 24 President and the Congress of the United States the decision
- 25 of the people of Puerto Rico.

- 1 (c) The election laws of the Commonwealth of Puerto
- 2 Rico shall apply to the referendum held under this Act. The
- 3 Governor of Puerto Rico shall prescribe such regulations
- 4 governing the conduct of the referendum under this Act as
- 5 may be necessary to supplement such laws in order to carry
- 6 out this Act.
- 7 SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.
- 8 There are hereby authorized to be appropriated such
- 9 sums as may be necessary for defraying the direct costs of
- 10 conducting the referendum provided for in this Act.
