1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

4 (1) the United States of America recognizes the 5 principle of self-determination and other applicable 6 principles of international law with respect to Puerto 7 Rico; and

8 (2) the United States is committed to a process of 9 consultation and negotiation with the people of Puerto
