Mr. Madden, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

- 1 Resolved, That upon the adoption of this resolution it
- 2 shall be in order to move that the House resolve itself into
- 3 the Committee of the Whole House on the State of the Union
- 4 for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 5945) to establish a
- 5 procedure for the prompt settlement, in a democratic man-
- 6 ner, of the political status of Puerto Rico. After general
- 7 debate, which shall be confined to the bill and shall continue
- 8 not to exceed two hours, to be equally divided and controlled
- 9 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Com-
- 10 mittee on Interior and Insular Affairs, the bill shall be read
- 11 for amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in
- 12 order to consider the substitute amendment recommended by

1 the Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs now in the bill

2 and such substitute for the purpose of amendment shall be

3 considered under the five-minute rule as an original bill. At

4 the conclusion of such consideration the Committee shall rise

5 and report the bill to the House with such amendments as

6 may have been adopted, and any member may demand a

7 separate vote in the House on any of the amendments

8 adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or com-

9 mittee substitute. The previous question shall be considered

10 as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final pas-

11 sage without intervening motion except one motion to recom-

12 mit with or without instructions.
